Selected Track requirements

General Education (45 semester hours) Courses should be chosen from the general education required discipline areas.

Track Core (48 semester hours) Courses must be selected from the recommended courses for the track selected or courses from similar disciplines based on the student's future goals. 30 of the semester hours must be upper division.

Elective Courses (27 semester hours) Courses may come from the same disciplines selected from the track core courses or may be chosen from other disciplines to complement the students' future goals.
